- ISWA has an excellent curriculum that incorporates internationally recognised educational principles and practices. This is currently based on the Advanced Placement (AP) program, a university preparatory program that is recognised by universities both within Australia and worldwide.
- The school offers an education to internationally recognised standards which is currently not available in West Australia.
- The International School of Western Australia is the only educational institution in Australia that offers the AP program and the International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma program.
- The school is one of only a handful capable of offering such a diverse international educational program in Western Australia.
- The International School of Western Australia is fully accredited by the Western Australian Government, certified by the Western Australian Minister for Education and also has international accreditation by the Western Association of Schools and Colleges (US).
- The International School of Western Australia has a well-respected faculty and internationally respected Principal.
- The International School of Western Australia offers students an education to inspire them to achieve academic excellence irrespective of gender, ethnicity or religion.
- Graduates and students of the International School of Western Australia evolve into global students and citizens of the world.
